



The Adult Competitive Sports Association (ACSA) is the national governing body for adult recreational and competitive sports leagues. We set standards, provide oversight, and support public facilities in offering safe and structured adult sports programs.

- ✓ Sanctions Adult Leagues & Events
- ✓ Provides Verified Players, Operators, & Officials
- ✓ Ensures Compliance & Safety

ACSA provides structure and oversight while you retain control of your facility.

Important to Know:

- ✓ ACSA does not run leagues or operate facilities. We set standards, verify participants, and provide compliance support.
- ✓ Local facilities retain full decision-making authority over scheduling, fees, policies, and rules.

Facilities Have Full Control Over:

- Scheduling & Access
- Rental Agreements
- Coaches, Fees, and Rules
- Daily Operations & Decisions

What Does "Sanctioned" Mean?

An ACSA-Sanctioned Event Operates Under Defined Standard



Benefits To Facilities:

No informal, ad-hoc leagues

Clear requirements for eligibility & conduct

Proven oversight of compliance and disputes



Insurance & Liability Support

What ACSA Provides

- ⊕ Minimum Insurance Standards
- ⊕ Verified Certificates of Insurance (COIs) for Each Event
- ⊕ Centralized Documentation on File
- ⊕ Streamlined COI Issuance to Facilities

What Facilities Avoid

- ⊕ Chasing Team Insurance
- ⊕ Unclear Coverage Terms
- ⊕ Inconsistent Policies
- ⊕ Last-Minute Documentation Gaps

Facilities retain the ability to require additional insurance endorsements at their discretion.

Safety, Conduct & Incident Handling

Incident Management Protocol

Staff can follow ACSA's proven safety protocols:

- ✓ Immediate first-aid protocols if needed
- ✓ Mandatory Incident Reports on file
- ✓ Clear Standards for Conduct Violations
- ✓ Direct Escalation Contacts on call

Always Available:

Trained, official ACSA members are always on standby to assist with incident management and resolution.
